

baby seal amigurumi



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For this project, I used worsted weight acrylic yarn and hook size H/8 (5.00 mm). You can use any size yarn you like. Be sure to adjust your hook size according to your yarn, tension, and preference. The size of the finished product varies.

Instructions:

Body: (starting at the tail)

R 1: ch 2, sc 6 into second ch from hook. (6)

R 2: *sc 1, sc 2 in next st* repeat. (9)

R 3-5: sc around. (9)

Finish off. You now have one tail fin.

Repeat Rounds 1-5 but do not finish off.

In Round 6 you are connecting the two tail fins by putting them together. When pushing the hook through a stitch to sc, push the hook through both stitches of the two tail fins and sc them together.

R 6: sc 3 in the manner described above, sc 12 normally clockwise. (12)

Place your stitch marker in this last stitch.

R 7: sc around. (12)

R 8: *sc 3, sc 2 in next st* repeat. (15)

R 9: *sc 2, sc 2 in next st* repeat. (20)

R 10: *sc 3, sc 2 in next st* repeat. (25)

R 11-14: sc around. (25)

R 15: *sc 4, sc 2 in next st* repeat. (30)

R 16-18: sc around. (30)

R 19: *sc 4, dec* repeat. (25)

R 20: *sc 3, dec* repeat. (20)

R 21: *sc 2, dec* repeat. (15)

R 22: *sc 3, dec* repeat. (12)

Stuff with fiberfill or other soft stuffing.

R 23: *sc 1, dec* repeat. (8)

Dec until shut. Finish off and use yarn tail to sew the hole shut.

Nose:

R 1: ch 2, sc 8 into second ch from hook. (8)

R 2: *sc 1, sc 2 in next st* repeat. (12)

R 3: sc around. (12)

R 4: *sc 5, sc 2 in next st* repeat. (14)

Slst, finish off.

Flippers: (make 2)

R 1: ch 2, sc 6 into second ch from hook. (6)

R 2: *sc 2, sc 2 in next st* repeat. (8)

R 3: sc around. (8)

R 4: *sc 3, sc 2 in next st* repeat. (10)

Slst, finish off.

Assembly:

Stuff the nose with fiberfill and attach it to the seal's head, covering the hole where you finished off. Stuff both the flippers and attach them on either side of the seal's body. Add eyes and a nose.
