

# simple cat amigurumi



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For this project, I used worsted weight acrylic yarn and hook size H/8 (5.00 mm). You can use any size yarn you like. Be sure to adjust your hook size according to your yarn, tension, and preference. The size of the finished product varies. Mine measures ...

## Abbreviations:

**BLO:** Crochet into the Back Loops Only

## Instructions:

### Head:

**R 1:** ch 2, sc 6 in second ch from hook. (6)  
**R 2:** sc twice in every stitch. (12)  
**R 3:** \*sc 1, sc 2 in next stitch, repeat from \* around. (18)  
**R 4:** \*sc 2, sc 2 in next stitch, repeat from \* around. (24)  
**R 5:** \*sc 3, sc 2 in next stitch, repeat from \* around. (30)  
**R 6:** \*sc 4, sc 2 in next stitch, repeat from \* around. (36)  
**R 7-14:** sc around. (36)  
**R 15:** \*sc 4, dec, repeat from \* around. (30)  
**R 16:** \*sc 3, dec, repeat from \* around. (24)  
**R 17:** \*sc 2, dec, repeat from \* around. (18)  
Finish off, leaving a long tail.

### Body:

**R 1-6:** Same as for rounds 1-6 of head.  
**R 7:** \*sc 5, sc 2 in next stitch, repeat from \* around. (42)  
**R 8:** In BLO, sc around. (42)  
**R 9-17:** sc around. (42)  
**R 18:** \*sc 5, dec, repeat from \* around. (36)  
**R 19-20:** sc around. (36)  
**R 21:** \*sc 4, dec, repeat from \* around. (30)  
**R 22-23:** sc around. (30)

**R 24:** \*sc 3, dec, repeat from \* around. (24)  
**R 25-26:** sc around. (24)  
**R 27:** \*sc 2, dec, repeat from \* around. (18)  
**R 28:** sc around. (18)  
Finish off.

### Ears: (make 2)

**R 1:** ch 2, sc 6 in second ch from hook. (6)  
**R 2:** sc twice in every stitch. (12)  
**R 3-6:** sc around. (12)  
Finish off, leaving a long tail.

### Tail:

**R 1:** ch 2, sc 6 in second ch from hook. (6)  
**R 2-18:** sc around. (6)  
Finish off, leaving a long tail.

## Assembly:

Stuff the head and body with fiberfill or other soft stuffing. Stuff the body until it is firm but do not over-stuff. Try to keep the bottom of the body flat so the cat can stand up straight. Sew head to body with the long tail of yarn. There's no need to stuff the cat's ears or tail. The tail can be curved slightly with no assistance; however, you may like to put a pipe-cleaner in it to make it poseable. Sew tail to the base of the body at the back and sew ears to head. Embroider nose and add whiskers if desired.
