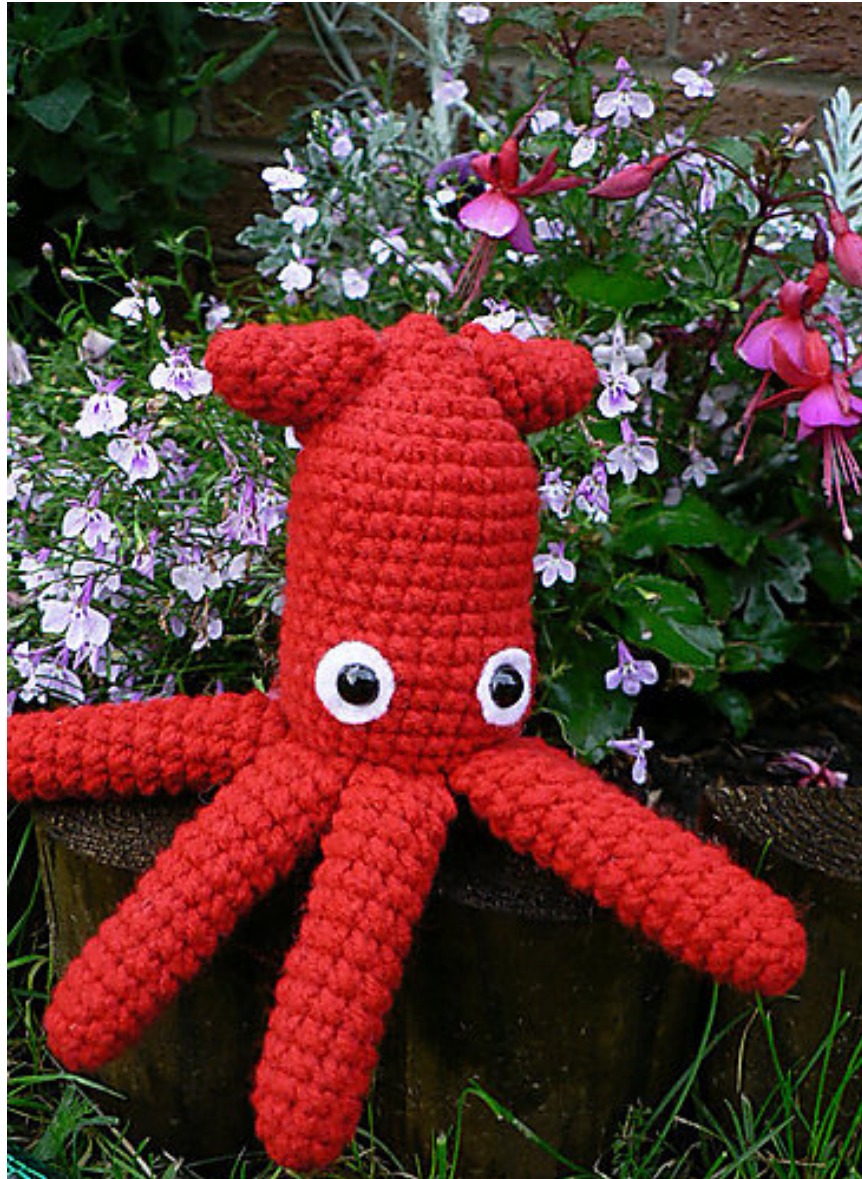


# *squid amigurumi*



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For this project, I used worsted weight acrylic yarn and hook size H/8 (5.00 mm). You can use any size yarn you like. Be sure to adjust your hook size according to your yarn, tension, and preference. The size of the finished product varies.

## Instructions:

### Body and Head:

**R 1:** ch 2, sc 4 in second ch from hook. (4)  
**R 2:** \*sc 1, sc 2 in next st\* repeat. (6)  
**R 3:** \*sc 2, sc 2 in next st\* repeat. (8)  
**R 4:** \*sc 1, sc 2 in next st\* repeat. (12)  
**R 5:** \*sc 1, sc 2 in next st\* repeat. (18)  
**R 6:** sc around. (18)  
**R 7:** \*sc 1, sc 2 in next st\* repeat. (27)  
**R 8-9:** sc around. (27)  
**R 10:** \*sc 7, dec\* repeat. (24)  
**R 11-13:** sc around. (24)  
**R 14:** \*sc 11, sc 2 in next st\* repeat. (26)  
**R 15:** sc 6, sc 2 in next st, sc 12, sc 2 in next st, sc 6. (28)  
**R 16-19:** sc around. (28)

Embroider the face. Stuff with fiberfill or other soft stuffing.

**R 20:** \*sc 5, dec\* repeat. (24)  
**R 21:** \*sc 2, dec\* repeat. (18)  
**R 22:** \*sc 1, dec\* repeat. (12)  
**R 23:** \*sc 1, dec\* repeat. (8)  
**R 24:** dec twice, slst.  
Finish off leaving a long tail.  
Sew opening closed.

### Fins: (make 2)

**R 1:** ch 2, sc 4 into second ch from hook. (4)  
**R 2:** \*sc 1, sc 2 in next st\* repeat. (6)  
**R 3:** sc 2, sc 2 in next st, sc 2 in next st, sc 2. (8)  
**R 4:** sc 3, sc 2 in next st, sc 2 in next st, sc 3. (10)

**R 5:** dec, sc 2, sc 2 in next st, sc 2 in next st, sc 2, dec. (10)  
**R 6:** sc 4, dc, dc, sc 4. (10)  
Slst, finish off leaving long tail for sewing the fins to the head.

### Arms: (make 8)

**R 1:** ch 2, sc 4 into second ch from hook. (4)  
**R 2:** \*sc 1, sc 2 in next st\* repeat. (6)  
**R 3:** \*sc 2, sc 2 in next st\* repeat. (8)  
**R 4-15:** sc around. (8)  
Slst, finish off.

### Assembly:

Stuff fins with fiberfill. Use safety pins to position them to the top of the head, and using a yarn needle, sew them on. Stuff the eight arms. Use safety pins to help ensure all eight arms will fit on the body. Use a yarn needle to sew arms to body.
